Gamification Process



Goals

To help conserve oceans by connecting users directly to marine organizations through a credit card.



Rules

Use the credit card for your personal purchases, and the bank/company automatically donates per amount to cause of your choice. If you round up transactions, you have the choice of adopting a coral.



Progress/Feedback

Users can see the stats of other friends on the app. There are leaderboards for corals planted, and an interactive map where you can see areas around the world where your friends have funded corals



Rewards

Users can obtain cashback rewards on partner businesses and earn in-app badges and points for completing tier goals. Users can also be mailed and have digital achievement certificates for certain accomplishments.



Motivation

Spend money, gain a credit score, and contribute to helping save the oceans all in one place. Not only are we giving you a lot of personal rewards, but you help frickin save the ocean.
